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






# U.S. Unemployment Rates Dropping












# US Dollar Compared to Chinese Yuan

Inverted Scale




# Oil Prices Show Volatility After Recent Lows




# Oil Prices Rising But Still Below Long Term Trend





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

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
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# Utah Population 7th Fastest Growing in U.S.




















# Consumer Price Index Wasatch Front vs. United States




# US Consumer Confidence Index vs. UT Consumer Attitude Index



## Median Existing Home Prices




# Utah Residential Construction Activity


